How the Clinic Works

When you arrive, you'll check in and meet privately with the staff member best suited to assist you.

During your confidential consultation, we'll:

- Answer your questions
- Provide information and guidance
- Assist with available services and resources whenever possible
- Connect you with community partners and referrals when additional assistance is needed

Our goal is for every visitor to leave with answers, support, or a clear next step.

Services May Include

- Housing information and resource navigation
- Victim advocacy and support
- Assistance with forms and applications
- Referrals to community agencies and partner organizations
- Information about available local services
- General questions about housing and victim-related resources
